THE NORSE PANTHEON

"IT IS UNWISE TO FORGET
THE OLD GODS."

The Norse pantheon is vast and largely lost to time. Here is a small introduction to some of its key players, particularly those important to our retelling.

THE AESIR: Gods of war & order.

- ~ **ODIN:** The all-father, ruler of the gods.
- ~ **FRIGG:** Wife to Odin, queen of the Aesir.
- ~ **THOR:** Son of Odin, protector of Midgard.
- ~ **SIF:** Wife of Thor, guardian of fertility, family, and harvest.
- ~ **BALDUR:** The golden, son of Odin and Frigg, most beloved.
- ~ **VIÐARR, VÁLI, HÖÐR** and **HERMÓÐR:** Sons of Odin.
- ~ **TYR:** The one handed, guardian of law, justice and war.
- ~ **HEIMDALL:** Guardian of Bifröst and watchman of Asgard.
- ~ **IDUNN:** Keeper of the apples of immortality.
- ~ **MIMIR:** Wise councillor to Odin.
- ~ **LOKI:** The trickster, blood brother to Odin.
- ~ **SIGYN, NARI** and **VÁLI** : Wife and sons of Loki.

THE VANIR: Gods of nature, fertility, and prosperity.

- ~ **NIJÖRÐR:** Guardian of the sea, father to Freyja and Freyr.
- ~ **FREYJA:** Powerful in sorcery (seiðr), chooser of the slain.
- ~ **FREYR:** Brother of Freyja, ruler of Alfheim.
- ~ **GULLVEIG:** Thrice burned.

THE JÖTNAR: Giants and ancient beings of chaos and nature.

- ~ **YMIR:** The primordial being, first of the Jötnar.
- ~ **BORR** and **BESTLA:** Father and mother of Odin, Vile and Vé.
- ~ **VILLE** and **VÉ:** Brothers of Odin, creators of the cosmos.
- ~ **ANGROBODA:** Lover of Loki, mother to monsters.
- ~ **FENRIR:** The great wolf, child of Loki
- ~ **JÖRMUNGANDR:** The great serpent, child of Loki
- ~ **HEL:** Half-dead ruler of Helheim, child of Loki
- ~ **SUTR:** Lord of Muspelheim, ruler of the fire Jötnar.
- ~ **SKÖLL:** Our namesake. He who mocks, son of Fenrir.
- ~ **HATI:** Our namesake. He who hates, son of Fenrir.

CREATION OF THE COSMOS

Before the world there was only **GINNUNGAGAP**, the great emptiness between the fires of Muspelheim and the frozen wastes of Niflheim. Where frost met fire, Ymir was born ~ first of the Jötnar ~ and the cosmic cow Audhumla, who nourished him with her milk. As Ymir slept, frost Jötnar sprang from his sweat and multiplied. Meanwhile, Audhumla licked at the salty ice of Niflheim, revealing Búri, forefather of the gods. From Búri's line came Vili, Vé and Odin.

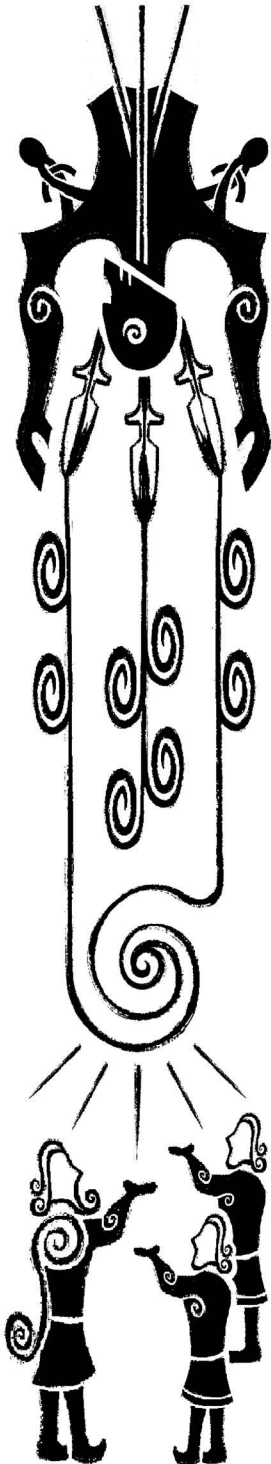
As they beheld the chaotic brood of the Jötnar, the young gods were horrified. They rose up and struck without mercy, slaying Ymir, whose blood gushed forth in a mighty flood, drowning all but one of his offspring. The brothers dragged **THE BODY OF YMIR** into the void, shaping from it the cosmos and dividing their creation into nine realms.

At the center of this new world stood **YGGDRASIL**, the great ash tree whose roots and branches bind the realms together, it's wellbeing tied to the fate of all existence. The world tree is nourished by **THREE SACRED WELLS** which govern fate, wisdom and order throughout the realms. It is also home to a variety of strange creatures: Veðrfölnir the hawk perches between the eyes of a great eagle atop its highest branch, four stags graze on its bark, and the squirrel **RATATOSKR** carries gossip between the eagle and the terrible dragon Nidhögg, who gnaws at the tree's roots trying to bring forth chaos.

From the sparks of Muspelheim formed Sol (sun) and Mani (moon) to illuminate the world and mark the passage of time. The gods set them in chariots, but when their charioteers proved unwilling, two monstrous wolves, **SKÖLL & HATI**, were set loose to chase them across the sky.

One day, while exploring the realms, Odin and his brothers found two tree trunks on a beach and gave them life. These were the first humans ~ Ask from Ash and Embla from Elm ~ they became the ancestors to all humankind and to them was given the realm of Midgard.

Finally, the gods created the **BÍFRÖST**, a bridge connecting Midgard to the realm of Asgard, from which the Aesir would rule.

DIVINE DEEDS

The large pantheon of gods who ruled over the nine realms were initially divided into two tribes, the Aesir and the Vanir. they coexisted in an uneasy peace for a time, but hostilities began when the Vanir goddess Gullveig was tortured ~ **THREE TIMES BURNED** ~ at the hands of the Aesir who became fearful of her Völva magic. The devastating Aesir-Vanir war erupted and fighting raged for millenia. When a decisive victory could not be achieved, hostages were exchanged and a truce was reached. The Vanir joined the Aesir in Asgard, to rule the Nine Realms as one.

The two sides cemented their peace by each spitting into a cauldron. from that mixture sprang Kvasir, the wisest being in existence. Kvasir's brilliance would be his doom however and he was murdered for his arrogance, his blood mixed with honey to create the **MEAD OF POETRY**.

There are many and more tales of the trials and tribulations that have taken place during the Aesir's rule. thor became **THE BEARDED BRIDE** to a giant, Freyr gave up his self-wielding sword for love, the gods grew old when the **APPLES OF IDUNN** were lost and two dwarven brothers wove a golden wig for Sif. But follow the threads from each of these unfortunate events and you're sure to find the mischief of Loki at play.

Not least of Loki's mischief were his monstrous offspring, destined to bring about calamity. The terrible Fenriswolf, the death-goddess Hel and the serpent **JÖRUMUNDGANDR**, who encircles the world.

To maintain order throughout the realms, the gods would often meet in council, but one day Baldur came to them complaining of baleful dreams filled with treachery and death.

Fearful of his son's dreams, Odin was quick to act and sought the prophecy of an ancient Völva, summoned from her grave. He presented her gifts in exchange for her prophetic words, the **VÖLUSPÁ**.

She spoke of all that was, all that must come and of a final war which would mark the end of Aesir rule and the destruction of all the realms.

TWILIGHT OF THE GODS

For generations, Odin has prepared to face the inevitable demise set out by the Völva's prophecy.

Relentlessly he sought the wisdom, giving his eye for a drink from Mimir's well, but still the riddles of fate eluded him. Unsatisfied with wisdom, he sought magic and sacrificed **HIMSELF TO HIMSELF**, in order to reveal the runes and attain their secret powers.

Next, he tasked the warrior maidens of Asgard, the **VALKYRIE**, to assemble an army. Gathering the greatest fallen warriors into Valhalla where they will feast and fight until the final battle.

Finally he plotted against those prophesised to move against him, casting the world serpent into the sea and ordering **THE BINDING OF FENRIR**, the monstrous wolf destined to devour Odin himself.

The stage was almost set, but it was **THE DEATH OF BALDUR**, most beloved of all the gods and first to die, whose murder set the wheels of doom in motion. His demise, a result of Loki's jealousy and treachery, finally pushed the Aesir to turn on the trickster god.

THE PUNISHMENT OF LOKI was severe, but as a blood brother to Odin, he could not be slain. Instead he was bound, tortured and abandoned. There he remains still, his hatred for the Aesir allowed to fester and grow, until the day comes when it can be unleashed.

For a long moment, the Aesir have enjoyed an era of peace and prosperity, but prophecy tells that it is in this moment of calm, that the dreaded **FIMBULVETR** will come, bringing three merciless years of cold, famine and war throughout the realms.

In that chaos, the children of Loki will begin to stir, writhe and shudder, spreading earthquakes throughout the worlds and weakening the chains of their father.

This winter is the herald of an apocalyptic battle ~ **RAGNARÖK**.

As Fimbulvetr ravages the worlds, crops wither and die, kin slays kin and oaths made in times of plenty crumble. As the crow of three roosters echoes through the realms, the gods watch in horror as the sky splits open with a howl. **SKÖLL AND HATI** catch their prey and as they devour the sun and moon, the stars gutter out and the world plunges into darkness.

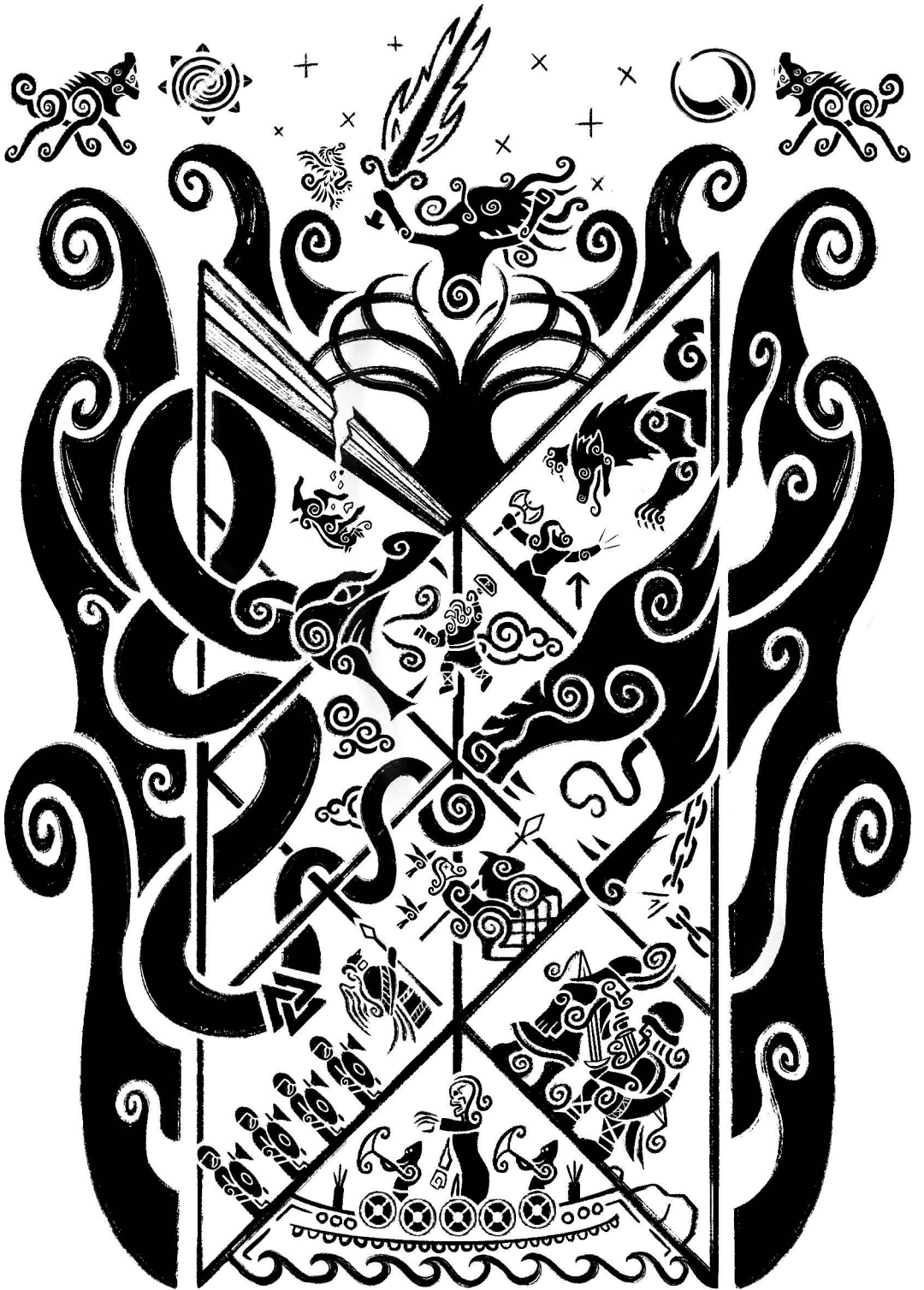
Jörmungander thrashes free of the seas and vomits venom across land and sky. Fenrir tears free of his binds and, driven mad by his captivity, opens his gaping jaws wide enough to devour the heavens. From the realm of the dead marches Hel and her ghastly host, urged forward by her half-rotten hand. And Loki, now free of his chains, his face burned and twisted with hate, steers the naglfar. This ship, made from the fingernails of the dead, brings his kin, the Frost Jötnar, to the battlefield.

Across the Bifröst rides Surtr, his sword blazing brighter than the sun. The flaming bridge shatters under his weight as Heimdall raises the Gjallarhorn to his lips. Odin takes his last council from the head of Mimir before ordering the Einherjar to march from Asgard with Valkyries riding before them. The Aesir arm themselves for a final stand upon the plains of Vigrid.

The clash is apocalyptic. Odin charges Fenrir and is swallowed whole. Viðarr, his silent son, comes forth to avenge him and tears the jaws of the great wolf apart. Thor meets Jörmungander and crushes his skull with Mjöllnir, only to stagger nine steps and collapse, succumbing to the serpent's poison. Heimdall challenges Loki, his ancient enemy, and they die side by side, impaled on each other's blades.

Finally Freyr stands alone against the mighty Surtr, but having traded his magic sword for love, he is cleaved in two. Surtr revels in his victory and sweeps his flaming blade across the sky, setting the very branches of Yggdrasil aflame. Seas boil, earth cracks and the sky fills with smoke as the Nine Realms burn to ash.

And yet ~ out of the smoldering ruin, life stirs. Two mortals, Lif and Lífþrasir, emerge from a charred tree stump and wander amongst the ashes beneath a new born sun. The world begins anew.

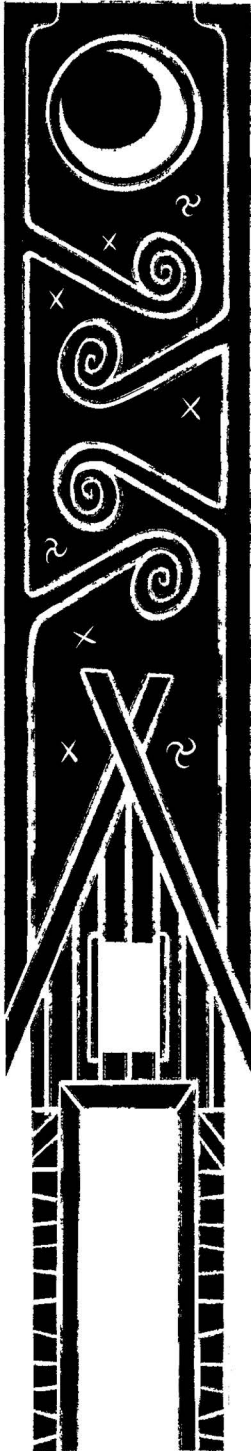

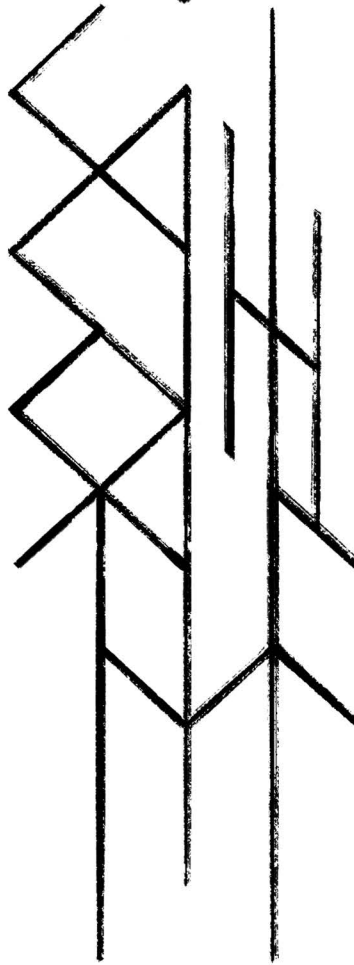
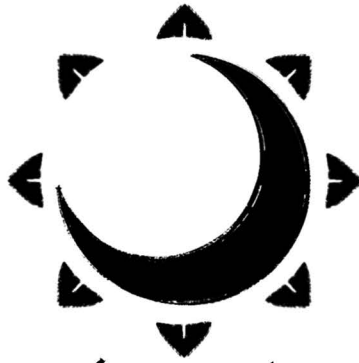
